



## How to Share Information from Kids InfoBits with Your Classes

A Gale Bookmark is a stable URL that will take a user to wherever you want to lead them in Gale databases and does not require authentication. It's a great way to share content with students and others! (Note: The URL in the Address bar is NOT stable and you cannot use this to direct others.) The two places to create Bookmarks in *Kids InfoBits* are: [Document View and Search Results View](#).

### Document View

1. **Locate a document** you want to share.
2. Click the **Bookmark** icon in the upper right of the screen.
3. **Highlight and copy** the link.
4. **Paste the link** into your class website, LMS, or anywhere else you can share it.

#### THIS IS HELPFUL WHEN:

- You want students to read an article at home.
- You don't want to print and waste paper.
- You want students to be able to use the Listen and Translate Tools.

### Search Results View

1. Conduct a **Basic or Advanced Search** for your topic or select a topic from the **Subject Topic Tree Images**.
2. On the search results page, click the **Bookmark** icon in the upper right of the screen
3. **Highlight and copy** the link.
4. **Paste the link** into your class website, LMS, or anywhere else you would like to share it.

#### THIS IS HELPFUL WHEN:

- You want to point students to a variety of articles from various sources to start their research.
- You want students to use resources for an assignment, but don't want to have to repeat the steps to have them conduct a search.
