

HOME PAGE

- 1. **Browse** by Publication using the magazine covers.
- 2. Utilize **Basic Search** to find specific content or content types.
- 3. Scroll to the bottom of the page to learn more about *National Geographic* and what's available at your library.

MAGAZINES

- 1. Select the **Browse Magazines** on the home page to access the Magazine Browse workflow.
- 2. **Limit By** allows you to choose a publication title or date.
- 3. Select a magazine to be launched into the content.

TOPICS BROWSE

- 1. Select **Explore Topics** on the homepage.
- 2. Browse topics to find content related to a topic of interest without running a search.
- 3. Select a topic using the images.
- 4. Launch the topic to find results from all content types.

TOPIC FINDER

- 1. Select **Topic Finder** under the **Advanced Search** option.
- 2. Type your search into the **Search Bar**.
- 3. Click into the interactive results to find topics of interest.
