Utilize this tip sheet to access your work assigned through the Gale platform. These quizzes are sent directly to your teacher for grading, so be sure to sign in correctly!

GET STARTED

Click on the link your teacher sent you.

On the homepage, enter your school's password, or sign in using your **Google** or **Microsoft** account.

If you're not sure how to sign in, ask your teacher.

LOCATE YOUR ASSIGNMENT

When you sign in, you'll be taken to a piece of content to view. It could be an article, video, or image.

A gray box labeled **Assignments** will appear under the title.

Select the assignment hyperlink to get started.

SIGN INTO YOUR ASSIGNMENT

After you select and read the assignment hyperlink you will be taken to a sign in page, this time to sign into the assignment so your teacher can identify you.

There are two different sign in options:

- **Create an Account:** Select **Sign Up** at the bottom of the page, and create an account with your name, email, and a password.
