

Incorporate *Gale In Context: For Educators* content, individualized folders, and assessments into your Canvas classes.


## ACCESS THROUGH CANVAS

## FIND AND CUSTOMIZE


Utilize the *Gale In Context: For Educators* tools to create folders, save content, add **Instructor's Notes**, and assign **Assessments**.

Use the rich content editor in an assignment, discussion, or quiz to access *Gale In Context: For Educators*.


Utilize the **Link To** or **Embed To** buttons within **Send To** to add Gale materials directly into your course.

Embed a Document




Places the entire result within your assignment, discussion, or quiz.

Students will see any **Instructor's Notes** or **Highlights** you added.

Select **Embed In Canvas** under **Send To** within any entry.


Link to a Document or Folder



Places a link to your content within the rich content editor.

Select **Link In Canvas** under **Send To** to include individual entries as well as fully customized folders.

Add a Resource With an Assessment



Link or Embed custom **Student Links** for documents with assigned assessments.

Link to custom **Student Links** for folders with assigned assessments.
