SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

White House Central Files

This collection of extensive presidential files from the Lyndon B. Johnson Library highlights the concerns of the president and his administration about the escalating war in Vietnam. The collection enumerates policies, responses, and recommendations from the president's advisers and cabinet members on handling the growing conflict, its effects on domestic policies, and the public's reaction to the war. In addition, this collection consists of public opinion mail both supporting the Administration's efforts and opposing those efforts.

The White House Central Files consists of materials from the most voluminous record group at the Lyndon Baines Johnson Library. The White House Central Files, designed as a reference service for the president and his staff to document White House activities, consist of four major components: the Subject File, Confidential File, Name File, and Chronological File. This microform publication comprises the Vietnam files of the National Defense category from the Subject File, but does not include the Name File, essentially an index to the Subject File, or the Chronological File, which contains miscellaneous outgoing correspondence.

The Subject series consists of essential correspondence and reports pertaining to the functions and operation of the White House; the federal government; and state, local, and foreign governments. Also filed in this series is correspondence from private individuals, companies, and organizations. The Subject series is organized alphabetically by subject title and then chronologically. The library has retained the original folder titles on the files, but a small number of files were assigned folder titles by a library archivist. These are denoted in brackets. The documentation in the Subject series is divided into sixty major subject categories and more than a thousand subcategories. Each subcategory is further subdivided into "Executive" and "General" material. The "Executive" material consists of documents of particular importance due to either their source or content and generally includes documents received from executive agencies and departments, members of Congress, foreign leaders, and presidential advisers. The "Executive" material also includes outgoing correspondence and memoranda, as well as other documents brought to the attention of the president or a designated White House aide. The "General" material consists of correspondence from the general public and other sources that, while noteworthy because it is addressed to the president, is not deemed as important as the "Executive" material from the viewpoint of level of handling or subject matter. The "General" material also includes routine correspondence from members of Congress and memoranda exchanged between lower-echelon executive branch officials.

FO (Foreign Affairs) Subject

The subject "Foreign Affairs" is used for material pertaining to international relations or in connection with the plans, policies, procedures, and programs regarding foreign countries or governments. This subject includes matters relating to the administration of foreign affairs, economic development, mutual security, and foreign information and exchange activities.

FO Foreign Affairs. General.

Contains daily reaction reports from U.S. Information Agency; correspondence, memoranda

and statements about world reactions. Also includes media reaction analysis by Office of Policy & Research.

FO/MC Foreign Affairs. Meetings and Conferences.

Correspondence, reports, memoranda concerning the White House Conference on International Cooperation. International Cooperation Year Committees, and National Foreign Policy Conferences for various groups (i.e. Business Executives, Educators).

FO 1 <u>Buildings – Grounds.</u>

Includes acquisition, ground-breaking ceremonies, construction operation, maintenance of embassies of both the U.S. and foreign countries.

FO 2 Diplomatic – Consular Relations.

Contains correspondence pertaining to embassy vacancies and talent hunt, activities of ambassadors, meetings, and general information subdivided by countries (CO#).

FO 2-1 Exequatur.

Consists of various correspondence about the recognition of consuls by the government of states in which they are stationed authorizing them to exercise their powers.

FO 2-2 Personal or Special Rank of Ambassador or Minister.

Recommendations and appointments of ambassadors/ministers for meetings and conferences to represent U.S.

FO 3 <u>Economic – Technical Development</u>.

Contains trade negotiations and economic development in emerging nations.

FO 3-1 International Waterways.

Includes permits for construction across U.S. boundaries, proclamations, meetings, fishing agreements, dam projects, and Chamizal project.

FO 3-2 Mutual Security.

Includes foreign aid, lend lease and defense support, military and technical assistance, foreign assistance

programs, Food for Peace program (PL 480).

FO 3-2-1 Alliance For Progress.

Correspondence and published material about Alliance for Progress programs in Latin America.

FO 4 Financial Relations.

Contains correspondence concerning international financial relations, banks, and International Monetary Fund.

FO 4-1 Balance of Payments.

Correspondence pertaining to conferences, committees, proposals, and meetings. (FO 4-1/MC Balance of Payment Conference).

FO 4-2 Loans – Funds.

Includes correspondence about loans and funds to foreign countries. Also loans by the Export Import Bank.

FO 4-3 International Investments.

Correspondence concerning foreign investments and financing promotional programs for U.S. corporations abroad.

FO 5 International Travel.

Includes tourism, administrative travel, international travel plans and rates.

FO 5-1 Letters of Introduction.

Correspondence from those traveling abroad who request letters of introduction.

FO 5-2 Passports – Visas.

Includes visa legislation; passports and visas for foreign and U.S. visitors.

FO 6 <u>Information – Exchange Activities</u>.

Reports, meetings, and conferences on international education and cultural affairs, task force on international education and correspondence concerning the East-West Center.

FO 6-1 Education Exchange Activities.

Includes international student exchanges and Fulbright Scholarships.

FO 6-2 <u>Scientific – Cultural – Business Exchange Activities</u>.

Correspondence pertaining to the exchange of scientific, cultural, and business information.

FO 6-3 Publicity, International.

Contains interviews, speech reactions, meetings and conferences with all types of news media, including press photographers and correspondents.

FO 6-3-1 Foreign Publications.

Editorials, reactions to/from various foreign publications.

FO 7 International Conferences.

Congressional representation and U.S. participation at international conferences. Subdivided by name of conference. Official top-level meetings of Chiefs of State or their representatives.

FO 8 <u>International Law.</u>

Includes rule of law, world court procedure, and law of the sea.

FO 9 Treaties.

Various correspondence about agreements, pacts or conventions, and treaties; list of treaties ratified by LBJ. Most treaties are filed under subject and cross-referenced here.
