THE ANGLO-AMERICAN COMMITTEE OF INQUIRY
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The Anglo-American Committee of Inquiry (AACI), formed in December of 1945, was created to study the situation of Jewish survivors of the Holocaust and the problems connected with their resettlement in Palestine. The members of the committee included Sir John Singleton, its British chairman and a judge; Herbert Morrison, a major tactician of the Labor party; Richard Crossman, a young Labor member of Parliament; Joseph Hutcheson, the U.S. chairman and also a judge; Dr. Frank Aydelotte, the director of the Institute for Advanced Studies at Princeton; Dr. James Macdonald, a professor at Columbia University and former League of Nations high commissioner for German refugees; and Bartley Crum, a San Francisco lawyer with pronounced Zionist leanings. The committee was charged with gathering information and making recommendations on 1) the effect of Jewish immigration and resettlement on the political, economic, and social conditions in Palestine; and 2) the position of surviving Jews in Europe and the possibility of relieving the problem by repatriation or resettlement of the survivors in Palestine and other non-European countries. The committee met first in Washington and moved to London in January 1946; it heard additional testimony in Cairo and Palestine in February and moved on to Lausanne in March to write its report. The committee recommended immediate authorization of 100,000 immigration certificates, which people needed to enter Palestine legally, and called for a unitary state rather than partition based on ethnicity or religious confession. The report was not received favorably in London but received immediate official date the report was issued officially, an action that provoked an angry response from the British cabinet.

These records, which are cataloged as NC3-43-77-2 (Lot 8) 71 A 6682 by the National Archives and Records Administration, are divided into five sections: 1) AACI Reference Files, 2) Evidence Submitted to the Committee, 3) Transcripts of Hearings, 4) AACI Reports, and 5) papers of the Anglo-American Cabinet Committee. The researcher should be aware that the materials listed as Evidence Submitted to the Committee were presented as supporting documentation by witnesses in the hearing, and these two sections should be used in close conjunction. The researcher should be aware also that many of the documents list on the Roll Contents contain enclosures, which can be lengthy.

The Roll Contents lists, for the most part, individual documents and, when the information is available on the document, the originating author or agency, the title or subject of the document, and the date. Where documents have been collected as a group, such as with the Monthly Reports of the Military Governor U.S. Zone, the individual documents are covered under a single listing. There is a certain amount of duplication of material in the file; where two copies of a document are filed together, both are included in the same listing, but, when copies appear in different locations in
