FOREWORD

The Intelligence Center, Pacific Ocean Area (ICPOA) was established in June 1942 to provide geographic, technical, and other forms of basic intelligence that were essential for the war against Japan. ICPOA was primarily staffed by naval personnel. During September 1943, in recognition of the importance of all services in the Pacific Ocean theatre, ICPOA was superseded by the Joint Intelligence Center, Pacific Ocean Area (JICPOA), which was a joint Army-Navy-Marine Corps organization. Both centers operated under the Commander in Chief Pacific and Pacific Ocean Areas (CINCPAC-CINCPOA).

Between June 1942 and the end of World War II, the size and functions of ICPOA-JICPOA expanded dramatically. From an initial staff of less than 200, the Center grew to include almost 1800 officers and men by the middle of August 1945. There was an equally significant increase in the functions undertaken by the organization. At the end of World War II, JICPOA was producing intelligence information on enemy bases or areas and reports based on captured Japanese documents or prisoner of war interrogations. It also analyzed captured enemy equipment, prepared hydrographic studies, issued target analysis data, provided escape and evasion information for military personnel operating in enemy-held territory, and supported psychological warfare efforts.

The 466 bulletins contained in this microfilm publication reflect these varied duties of ICPOA and JICPOA. The documents are

arranged chronologically, with the last two digits in their numbers representing the year of publication. Bulletins 1-42 through 9-43 were issued by ICPOA and those designated 10-43 through 111-44 by JICPOA. Bulletins numbered 112-44 through 3-46 appeared under the imprint of CINCPAC-CINCPOA, but they also were prepared by JICPOA.

With the exception of a few items which are not included in the collection of the Operational Archives or apparently in other repositories, the series is complete. A comprehensive report of ICPOA and JICPOA activities appears on the first reel of this publication and includes a master list of all documents issued by those organizations.
