Introduction

Assistant Secretary of the Treasury Harry Dexter White was one of the highest-ranking New Deal officials accused of espionage by Communist-underground-couriers-turned-government-informants Elizabeth Bentley and Whittaker Chambers. Instrumental in shaping postwar international monetary policy, White coauthored the plans that created the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank and served as the American executive director of the International Monetary Fund.

In 1948, Bentley accused White of passing confidential documents to members of a Communist spy ring. Chambers claimed that White had provided him with information and documents at several meetings between the two men in the 1930s. White denied the accusations when he appeared before the House Un-American Activities Committee (HUAC) in August 1948. Two days after his testimony before the committee, White died of a heart attack, leaving many questions about his activities unanswered.

The FBI file on Harry Dexter White contains reports, correspondence, news clippings, and four pages of White's documents that were found in a hollow pumpkin on Chambers's Maryland farm in 1948.
