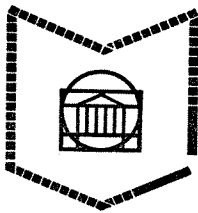

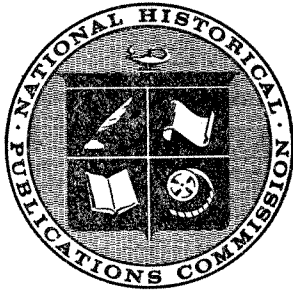

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Introduction

The Papers of Robert Mercer Taliaferro Hunter, 1817—1887, are a segment of the Hunter—Garnett Collection, given to the University of Virginia Library between 1937 and 1941 by Mrs. James Clayton Mitchell, a cousin of Hunter. The entire collection covers the period 1704 to 1940, with the bulk of the manuscripts consisting of R. M. T. Hunter's letters, speeches, business papers, and ledgers, and those of his immediate family.

The collection, a nearly complete record of a representative Virginia family with all of its connections and associations in the period surrounding the Civil War, demonstrates the impact of that war on the family and its attempts to recoup its consequent losses. The collection is useful because of the long period covered, Hunter's position on the political stage, and the diversity of other public and private topics mentioned.

Bibliographical Note

The R. M. T. Hunter Collection at the University of Virginia Library is the most extensive collection of Hunter papers known to be in existence. In addition to the more than 3,000 items filmed on this thirteen-roll microfilm edition, all of Hunter's business records and ledger books are available in the Manuscripts Division of the University of Virginia Library. The second largest volume of Hunter materials is located at the Virginia State Library and consists of 875 items, one-third of which have been published in Charles Ambler's *Correspondence of R. M. T. Hunter, 1826—1876*, in the *Annual Report of the American Historical Association*, 1916, vol. II (Washington, 1918).

In addition to these two large collections, there are Hunter items in the William Garnett Chisholm Collection and the James L. Kemper Papers at the Virginia Historical Society; the John C. Calhoun Papers at Clemson University; the John Francis Hamtramck Papers and the Munford and Ellis Family Papers at the Duke University Library; and the Francis Willett Shearman Collection at the University of Michigan Library. Scattered Hunter items may also be found in several collections of Presidential papers and Civil War records in the National Archives and the Library of Congress.

Public documents which contain papers of Hunter include *The Congressional Globe: 25th Congress—36th Congress* (Washington, 1837—1861); *A Compilation of the Messages and Papers of the Confederacy* (2 vols., Nashville, 1906); *Journal of the Congress of the Confederate States of America, 1861—1865* (7 vols., Washington, 1904—1905); *Official Records of the Union and Confederate Navies in the War of the Rebellion* (30 vols., Washington, 1894—1922); *The War of the Rebellion: A Compilation of the Official Records of the Union and Confederate Armies* (70 vols., Washington, 1880—1901); and *Journal of the House of Delegates, Virginia* (Richmond, 1874).

Hunter published a number of articles and letters in *Southern*

Historical Society Papers, including "Origin of the Late War," I, 1—13; "The Peace Commission of 1865," III, 168—176; "Instructions to James M. Mason," VII, 236—241; and "Letter to Hon. John Slidell," XIII, 455—466. The Hunter-Calhoun relationship is described in J. Franklin Jameson's edition of *Correspondence of John C. Calhoun* in the *Annual Report of the American Historical Association*, 1899, vol. II (Washington, 1900); and the conflict between Jefferson C. Davis and Hunter is revealed in Dunbar Rowland's *Jefferson Davis, Constitutionalist: His Letters, Papers, and Speeches* (10 vols., Jackson, 1923). Information concerning Hunter's role in the Hampton Roads Peace Conference is included in Roy Basler's edition of *The Collected Works of Abraham Lincoln*, vol. 8 (New Brunswick, N. J., 1953).

Secondary works of a biographical nature include John E. Fisher's "Statesman of the Lost Cause: The Career of R. M. T. Hunter, 1859—1887," (M. A. Thesis, University of Virginia, 1966); *Life of R. M. T. Hunter* by Henry H. Simms (Richmond, 1935); and *A Memoir of R. M. T. Hunter* by Martha T. Hunter (Washington, 1903). Contemporary sketches of Hunter are contained in D. W. Bartlett's *Presidential Candidates: Containing Sketches, Biographical, Personal, and Political of Prominent Candidates for the Presidency in 1860* (New York, 1859) and John Savage's *Our Living Representative Men* (Philadelphia, 1860). Other biographical writings on Hunter include Charles Ambler's sketch in the *Dictionary of American Biography*; D. R. Anderson's article, "R. M. T. Hunter," in *The John P. Editorial Procedure

The Papers of R. M. T. Hunter, 1817—1887, are divided into two series, and each is arranged chronologically. Roll One, the first series, consists of all manuscript and printed speeches of Hunter in the University of Virginia Library's collection. The second series, Rolls Two through Thirteen, includes the personal, public, and business papers of Hunter and his family.

Each item in this collection is preceded on the microfilm by an identification tag which indicates its date, originator, recipient, and, when appropriate, its title. Other information—such as the condition of the manuscript when fragmented, and the existence of duplicates or variant drafts—may also be found on the identification tag in brackets. Undated items have been dated by internal evidence whenever possible; such dates appear on the identification tags in brackets. Roll One is preceded by a list of all speeches microfilmed; Rolls Two through Thirteen are divided into equal segments, preceded by flash targets, and identified by inclusive dates at the beginning of each roll. Targets are also included to indicate the change in date from one year to the next. All items were filmed at a reduction ratio of twelve to one, with the exception of some over-sized newspapers and maps, which were filmed at a larger reduction ratio. Frame numbers, beginning anew on each roll, were included to facilitate citation and location of items and to provide a basis for indexing.

Finding aids in this *Guide* include Roll Notes, a brief description of the arrangement and contents of each roll, and a List of Correspondents, which gives the name of the originator and the date of each letter microfilmed.

Roll Notes

Roll One: 1828—1876

Speeches

On this roll are sixty-three speeches of R. M. T. Hunter, considered one of the leading orators of the South for nearly fifty years. These speeches, both manuscript drafts and printed copies, demonstrate the variety of audiences to whom Hunter spoke, and include political speeches in the U. S. House of Representatives and Senate, campaign speeches on behalf of the Democratic Party, and lectures to a literary society at the University of Virginia. Some of the most interesting speeches are Hunter's post-Civil War orations, which were intended to encourage the re-establishment of the Democratic Party in the South. His speech in New York in September 1872 is significant because he was the first southerner after the war to speak before a northern political rally. A complete list of the speeches is given at the beginning of the microfilm roll.

Roll Two contains personal papers concerning Hunter's education, early legal practice, and the beginnings of his political career during the period in which he rose from a rural lawyer to the position of Speaker of the U. S. House of Representatives. Most of the correspondents are relatives, personal friends, and clients.

Roll Three contains papers concerning the emergence of Hunter as a national political figure. Letters from Albert Gallatin, John C. Calhoun, R. B. Rhett, Thomas Ritchie, James A. Seddon, and other Democratic leaders indicate the national character of Hunter's political connections. One of the significant groups of letters on this roll concerns Calhoun's attempt to become the presidential candidate in 1844 and Hunter's assistance as his campaign manager. Another group pertains to General Winfield Scott's effort to secure the rank of Brevet Lieutenant-General.

Roll Four: 1852—1856

Roll Four reveals Hunter as one of the dominant public figures of his times. Many papers on this roll describe land transactions of Hunter as a member of the "Washington Clique," a group composed of national politicians interested in land speculation. Papers of a political nature continue to play an important part in this roll, showing Hunter as a member of the "Southern Triumvirate" with Jefferson C. Davis and Robert Toombs. Papers regarding Hunter's work as chairman of the Senate Finance Committee and the Military Affairs Committee are interleaved throughout the family letters of this period. Important correspondents include Franklin Pierce, Herschel V. Johnson, Richard Rush, Jefferson C. Davis, W. W. Corcoran, John L. Dawson, and Muscoe R. H. Garnett.

Roll Five consists primarily of family letters written during the period when Hunter was particularly interested in the education of his son, R. M. T. Hunter, Jr., a student at the University of Virginia. In addition, there are a number of documents which reveal Hunter's continuing interest in land and other financial ventures.

Roll Six contains personal correspondence similar to that in the preceding roll. In the 1860 correspondence, however, there are letters from Lucius Q. Washington and other friends who attempted to secure for Hunter the Democratic presidential nomination at the Charleston convention. Following the papers which indicate the failure of this effort are a number of letters asking Hunter to speak for the Breckinridge-Lane ticket.

Correspondence contained on Roll Seven reveals the private life of the Hunter family during the Civil War. There are several

important documents about Hunter's Confederate career, such as his account of the Hampton Roads Peace Conference, held February 3, 1865. Half of this roll is devoted to the year 1865 and particularly to letters written to Hunter at Fort Pulaski, Georgia, following his arrest and imprisonment there.

While at Fort Pulaski, Hunter wrote a "History of Confederate Finance" and a treatise entitled "Nature of Man," both of which are included on this roll. The majority of the papers of this period deal with Hunter's release from prison and the re-establishment of his mills in Virginia. Of interest is the group of letters and documents concerning Hunter's official parole. Hunter's attempts to recoup his heavy financial losses are reflected in the business papers on this roll. Important correspondents include W. W. Corcoran, John L. Dawson, James A. Seddon, Andrew Johnson, and Edwin M. Stanton.

These manuscripts continue to show Hunter's efforts to re-establish himself financially. Of particular importance are the West Virginia and Wisconsin land documents. A significant public paper which appears on this roll is Hunter's plea for the "Relief of Virginia," a petition he delivered to the U. S. Congress.

Roll Ten contains letters and other papers which illustrate Hunter's business difficulties and his continuing efforts to achieve financial stability. Of special interest are the papers of the New York Industrial Exhibition, of which Hunter was one of the regents for the State of Virginia.

Roll Eleven contains a number of letters between Hunter and Augustus Schell, chairman of the Democratic Party, concerning Hunter's address to the Democratic rally in New York City in September 1872. The papers in this period are primarily of a political nature and include invitations for Hunter to speak and letters revealing his efforts to obtain his old Senate seat. Of special interest are the letters relating to the organization of the Southern Historical Society.

Segment I of Roll Twelve includes public documents concerning Hunter's election as Treasurer of Virginia. Personal

correspondence from Hunter, during his stay in Richmond as Treasurer, to his wife and children constitutes the major portion of this roll.

The papers on this roll cover the last years of Hunter's life—his defeat in 1880, the death of his daughter Evelyn in 1881, and his last political appointment as Collector of the Port of Tappahannock in 1885. Noteworthy are the letters from Thomas Clemson, asking Hunter to write a biography of John C. Calhoun, and the letters concerning the organization of the Mutual Endowment Association by Hunter.

Also included on this final roll of microfilm are certain undated items, including a plan of the town of Beaufort, Virginia; a number of papers on Hunter's land in Nicholas County, West Virginia; and his notes on the Anglican Church in Virginia.

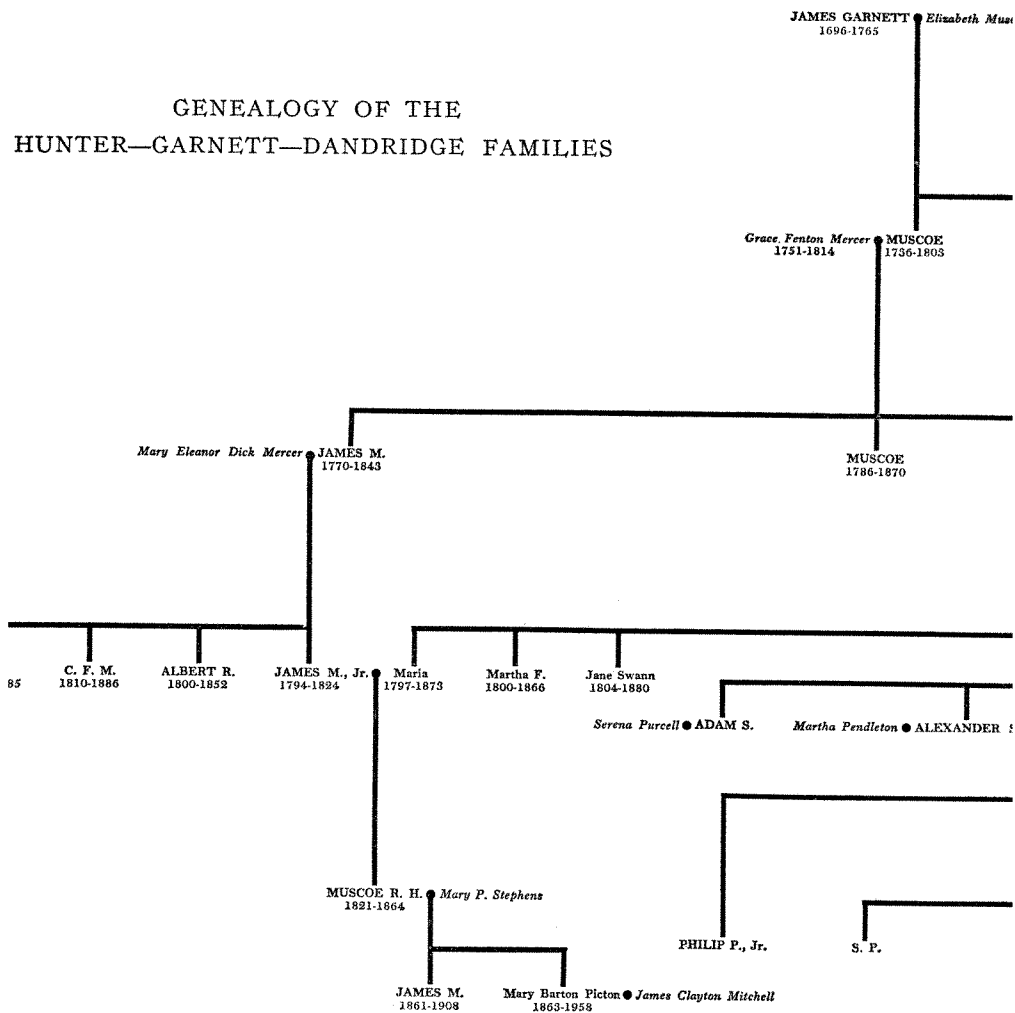
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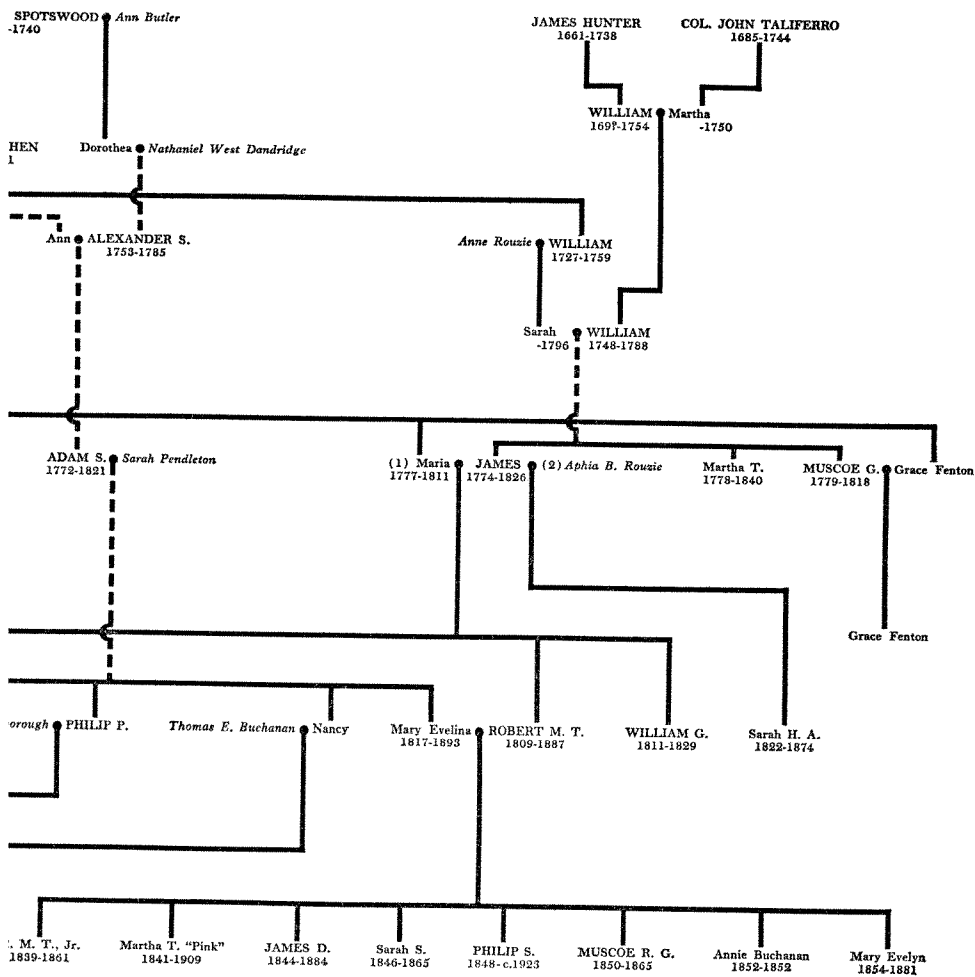
