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INTRODUCTION

The **History of Education**, a retrospective monograph collection on microfiche, consists of educational treatises and general works in education published from the fifteenth through the nineteenth centuries. As a research collection, **History of Education** is designed to be comprehensive in scope, encompassing five centuries of published educational material. Modern educational theory and practice has been profoundly influenced by the major writers contained in this collection. The **History of Education** will be based on the extensive holdings of the Milbank Library, Teachers College at Columbia University, and the inclusion of holdings from other institutions is in the planning stages.

The collection will be published four times yearly and each unit will contain approximately 1,250 microfiche cards. Unit 10 contains microfiche numbers 11,259 - 12,508 with a total of 637 titles. This unit contains much material on 19th Century American university education, particularly Harvard University, but also includes works on the University of Edinburgh and University of Cambridge as well. Authors included are Charles Kendall Adams, Sophie Bryant, Phillip Kelland, Richard Kukula, Casar von Lengerke, August Kohler, Richard Green Moulton, John Henry Newman, R.D. Roberts and Adam Sedgwick.

The **History of Education** collection will eventually contain 9,000 to 12,000 titles on 98-frame positive microfiche with a reduction ratio of 24X. This film, employing a silver halide emulsion, meets all industry standards for archival permanence. The microfiche heading has been designed to industry standards. The eye-legible, abbreviated title of each work is centered on the top line of the Document Description Area, with the author and imprint date appearing directly beneath. The information contained in the right-hand field of the heading, the Sequential Information Area, offers identification unique to the work: the sequential fiche number, the number of fiche cards containing that title, their order of sequence, and the number of pages contained on the card. The Identification Area is left blank for local information which libraries may wish to add to the heading. Each entry in this guide contains the main entry, title, imprint information, and its sequential fiche number, or range of numbers.
