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INTRODUCTION

The numerical catalog and alphabetical index covers all 402 of the main policy cases and all of the some 2,045 subcases, or numbered "slants" or "slashes," that were handled during World War II and the early postwar years of the cold war by the United States government's senior interdepartmental committee for national security policies. That committee was known first as the State-War-Navy Coordinating Committee (SWNCC), from December 1944 to September 1947. Subsequently, as part of the reorganization of the government's security apparatus under the National Security Act of 1947, the new Department of the Air Force was added to SWNCC's membership and the expanded committee was renamed the State-Army-Navy-Air Force Coordinating Committee (SANACC). SANACC's work continued from October 1947 to June 1949 when the remainder of the SANACC apparatus and agenda were absorbed into the structure of the National Security Council.

The main catalog entries for SWNCC 1 to SANACC 402, inclusive, were compiled for the Scholarly Resources microfilm edition of these case files first to serve as footnotes on the microfilmed texts themselves, in each of the 402 case files; second, to provide a table of contents at the front of each of the thirty-two microfilm rolls; and finally, to be consolidated herein as part of Scholarly Resources's comprehensive index-guide volume covering the entire corpus of case files, totaling some 40,000 pages of text on microfilm.

The microfilm coverage includes the full text of all declassified SWNCC and SANACC case papers, excluding duplicates, together with the many items of related interagency and inter-Allied correspondence at headquarters and in the field, notably the memoranda of the Joint Chiefs of Staff and of the many subcommittees, working groups, and ad hoc committees of SWNCC and SANACC. Each text has been faithfully restored to its original file position and properly indexed and cross-referenced in the present guide. Scholarly Resources historical editors are responsible for the recent declassification of many documents in the collection; in the course of this editorial project, some 700 Freedom of Information Act appeals for downgrading were addressed to the government's security-review authorities.

Each of the main case entries, when used by the scholar with the alphabetical index that follows, provides a full summary of a given case file--the range of policy topics covered, the countries or localities and regions involved, the organizational complexities revealed, the date span during and/or after World War II, and the page count for a given case folder. Precise locational references to each case file are shown in the right-hand column, first to the specific Scholarly Resources microfilm roll and then to the microfilm page numbers. Also noted for each case entry is a reference to a given LP (that is, to the "List of Papers" normally filed at the front of a given case folder), which serves as an excellent supplementary index, in chronological order, to all of the individual documents which originally had been filed on that case by the SWNCC/SANACC secretariat and which are now made available for research in this unique facsimile-on-microfilm edition. The list of subcases under the main case entries, ranging numerically from SWNCC 1/1 to SANACC 402/2, was derived from the official "numerical index" which was compiled in October 1948 by the SANACC secretariat and which has now been expanded, updated, and corrected by the editor of the present index-guide volume.

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ALPHABETICAL SUBJECT INDEX to SWNCC and SANACC Case Papers 1 to 402

This subject index in a single alphabet, which should be consulted by the researcher in conjunction with the companion numerical-chronological index to the case files, comprises a consolidation of the SANACC secretariat's own final index compiled in 1948 (137 pp. with approximately 2,500 main entries and subentries). In the present expansion of that index (and in a shorter format), about 500 new main headings and subheadings have been added, based on a fresh historical analysis and synthesis of a variety of additional significant key words and policy concepts of research interest that have been detected and recovered from the files--from the case titles, the LP indexes (lists of papers), and the texts themselves. In this expansion, moreover, many ubiquitous and misleading ambiguous key words found in the original index have been omitted, e.g., such key-word terms as area, change, policy, procedure, program, project, provision, representatives, foreign, and nations; while other new and more precise key-word concepts, omitted in 1948, have been introduced in this revision, e.g. Communist, propaganda, neutrality, price control, quadripartite, radio frequencies, resistance forces, etc. The subentries, likewise have been expanded and consolidated, especially for the larger extensively documented countries and major policy issues; the subheadings are usually presented in proper historical chronological-sequential order (rather than slavishly alphabetical). Many cross references have been added, liberally but prudently. The result, in a single alphabet, is an attempt to cover all foreign countries, regions, and localities that are found significantly documented in the United States government's foreign policy concerns from 1944 to 1949, along with the many topics of wartime and postwar national interest, organizations and agencies involved, titles of report series, and bureaucratic acronyms that were so commonly used as shorthand in the texts and indexes of the SWNCC and SANACC committee deliberations.
