BRITAIN AND EUROPE DURING 1993

The bibliographical guide to <u>Britain and Europe during 1993</u> accompanies the PSS microfiche collection of material produced throughout 1993. It is the twenty first supplement to the 'package' <u>Britain and Europe Since 1945</u>, (previously published by Harvester Press Microform Publications Ltd.), which contains 26,000 pages of literature issued by 67 groups and organisations between 1945-1972. This update includes material contributed by 37 groups and organisations and in addition to material produced in 1993, there are a number of items of an earlier date, not previously included.

Various events were held in January 1993 to herald the arrival of The Single Market and UK Prime Minister John Major declared that 1993 would begin "a new era of confidence and friendship in Europe".

However throughout 1993 the crisis in the former Yugoslavia again continued to overshadow the Community and much aid was sent to attempt to alleviate the suffering there.

In March and April Commission President Jacques Delors met with US President Bill Clinton in an attempt to consolidate EC-US relations.

In May a Eurobarometer poll was held in the Community to gauge the amount of support for the Maastricht Treaty. The results showed that the British and the Irish were the most optimistic about the opportunities offered by The Single Market.

Baroness Thatcher continued to keep a high profile in the Maastricht Treaty debate and in July called for a referendum in the UK, a move which was rejected by a massive margin by the Government.

The Maastricht Treaty was finally ratified on 1 November 1993 and Jacques Delors declared that it would "release the European Community from a period of inertia and disillusionments and provide the main stimulus for the Twelve to recover from economic stagnation". The second stage of Economic and Monetary Union is due to begin on 1 January 1994.

PLACE/DATE OF PUBLICATION/AUTHORSHIP

Publication dates are given as in the original imprint, except for undated items. Where the date of publication (or origination) has been inferred from reliable internal or external evidence the conventional form has been adopted: n.d. 1993? Where no named author is listed the item was issued anonymously. The place of publication is normally the address of the issuing body.

HOW TO USE THE INDEX

As with the first collection and previous updates concerned with the Single Market debate, this update – which contains 1993 material issued during 1993 – is arranged on the same easily-used and fully-indexed system. In a matter of moments the index takes you from your need for a particular item to the exact document you require.

PSS UNIQUE PAGE NUMBERS

The PSS unique page number again appears at the top of each page. As before the number on the first page of each document is the reference allocated to that particular document. This is the reference you will find in the index. Thus an item of 16 pages with the page numbers, say 80-95, will be identified by number 80. The numbering of each group in the 1993 update follows in sequence from the numbering of the material produced by the group in the last collection. For example, the last page of British Housewives League in Britain and Europe during 1992 was numbered 612 so the first page of British Housewives League in the 1993 update is 613.

HOW TO FIND AN INDIVIDUAL ITEM ON MICROFICHE

This follows the same principles as in the previous collection. Consult either the Chronological Index, the Author Index, or the Title Index to find the title you want. Each document has been allocated a two-letter code. Before this code is a number, which identifies the 'package' followed by 1993 in brackets, which signifies the year of the update. The number after the two letter code is the number of the specific document.

Suppose you want to read an extract of a speech by Tony Blair M.P. from the <u>Labour Movement in Europe</u> 7 January 1993. You can look for it in any of three places.

A. Chronological Index

You know that the item was issued by The Labour Movement in Europe. In the Chronological Index this group is given the <u>Britain and Europe since 1945</u> package number 1, the update number 1993 and the two-letter code OY. Thus the Labour Movement in Europe looks like this:

1(1993)OY

1 is the 'package' reference. (1993) is the year of the update. OY is the group reference.

Each document has been allocated a unique number within the group and this particular document will look like this:

B. Title Index

In the Title Index it appears like this:

C. Author Index

1(1993)OY 3069 is the unique code for this specific document and in the Author Index it appears like this:

BLAIR, Tony M.P. Speech at a meeting of the American European Community Association, New York. Labour Movement in Europe. 7 January 1993, 6pp. 1(1993)OY 3069.

When you have the complete code for the document, find the 'package' in the PSS collection. This is easily identified through the eye-readable name of the 'package' and through the 'package' number '1' which precedes each code. To identify the year of the update look at the date in brackets next to the package

number e.g. (1993).

Then locate the group by the two-letter code. Then pick out the fiche on which the document number appears. Several documents are often filmed on one fiche and the fiche reference will read 1(1993)OY 2990-3079. Your document 1(1993)OY 3069 will appear on this fiche. Insert the fiche in the micro-viewer and move the fiche to read the document you want.

SCOTLAND AGAINST BEING RULED BY EUROPE (SABRE) (formerly SCOTTISH ANTI COMMON MARKET COUNCIL 170 Portobello High Street, Edinburgh, Scotland EH15 1EX

"The organisation is a centre for the collection and publication of information on the policies and changing nature of the EC and EU. Membership is open to individuals and groups in Scotland, elsewhere in the UK and abroad, who share the organisation's aims, seeking to achieve them in democratic and parliamentary ways. It is strictly non-party, drawing executive and membership from supporters of all the mainstream parties.

Its aims are:

- To alert Scotland to defend its liberties and the freedom of the individual now endangered. These are being destroyed by continued membership of the European Community.
- To assert our political independence of the European Community.
- To recover our economic independence of the European Community.
- To co-operate with other anti-EU groups in and furth of Scotland".

SCOTTISH PATRIOTS

"The Scottish Patriots, founded by the late Wendy Wood in 1945 emerged from general moves for Scottish Independence between the Wars into its own identity in the immediate post-World War II years. It has consistently

preached severance of Government from Westminster but left the status of the monarchy unopposed. The movement's basic opposition is to all forms of centralisation, especially now as found in the European Union. The editorial line of their publication *The Patriot for Scotland* is uncompromising: exit of the UK and Scotland, unilaterally, from the European Union. The content of *The Patriot for Scotland* is, by necessity, primarily political but it also seeks to protect and promote Scottish heritage and culture".

SOCIAL CREDIT SECRETARIAT 76 Constitution Street, Edinburgh, Scotland EH6 6RP

"The Social Credit Secretariat, founded by the late Major C H Douglas, in 1933, seeks to protect and uphold the analysis and remedy he offered on the economic and political (and hence social) ills of the world. He found that there was a fundamental flaw in global and national accountancy, leading to 'poverty in the midst of plenty'. His answer, however, went further than simple re-distribution of wealth, rather seeking to ensure a minimum living standard for all, by way of a 'right' to a national dividend for every citizen. The consumer would thereby have the means to pay for consumption. This he called 'applied Christianity'.

The basis of such an operation would be the sovereignty of the individual, the primacy of local accountability and the elimination of centralisation and usury. This requires opposition to the construction and conduct of the European Union and so considerable attention is paid to this aspect of international and national affairs. The Social Credit Secretariat seeks to implement the founder's doctrines in today's situation, expressed in today's terms, through the original books and writings of C H Douglas, subsequent Social Credit apologists and the commentary of *The Social Crediter*, its official periodical. The Social Credit Secretariat is non-class, non-party and non-sectarian."
