PUBLISHER'S NOTE

The John Rylands University Library in Manchester holds by far the most substantial and significant collection of manuscripts by Elizabeth Gaskell in the world. This microfilm edition presents the collection alongside complementary literary manuscripts and correspondence from other nineteenth century writers, in a format which gives unprecedented opportunity for the study of primary source material relating to the work of Gaskell, Dickens and the phenomenon of the 1840s 'Social Novel'.

The manuscripts are presented throughout in catalogue order, with the 'University English' class appearing on Reel One, and the main manuscript sequence follows on from Reel Two. Literary manuscripts are therefore interspersed with correspondence throughout the edition. Among the highlights of the literary manuscripts is the full working manuscript of Wives and Daughters, Gaskell's only novel to have survived in full in draft form.

The original manuscript of her controversial biography of Charlotte Bronte, containing the supposedly libellous passages omitted from the first edition in 1857 is accompanied here by Gaskell's correspondence with her subject, and later, Charlotte's father, Patrick Bronte. Two short stories, The Grey Woman and The Crooked Branch complete the creative works of Elizabeth Gaskell presented here, but an illuminating sequence of correspondence with Charles Dickens discusses her work on North and South and Cranford, and offers unique insight into the creative processes behind these novels. Further correspondence between Elizabeth Gaskell and friends and fellow writers such as Matthew Arnold, Jane Carlyle, Charles Kingsley, Caroline Norton, John Ruskin, W.M. Thackeray and William Wordsworth discuss her childhood, family, reading and work.

This microform collection also includes Dickens' own manuscript short story A Child's Dream of a Star (sent as a gift to Elizabeth Gaskell) and a fine, extra-illustrated Life of Dickens including much manuscript and rare printed material. Noteworthy inclusions are a letter from John Dickens, his father, some 35 letters by Dickens himself, one of his own shorthand books, the manuscript of a speech he delivered to the Royal Academy, illustrations and playbills concerning his involvement in amateur theatricals, and a rare collection of dramatizations from his works.

We have also taken the opportunity to include a number of manuscripts from other writers of this period. The correspondence of Maria Jane Jewsbury and Mary Russell Mitford describes the literary endeavours of two other leading women writers. Papers of Thomas Carlyle, John Marriott, Walter Savage Landor, and William Makepeace Thackeray provide valuable sources for students of these authors.

Autograph collections were a particular passion of the Nineteenth Century and two fine examples round out this publication. One is the extensive collection of the Reverend Thomas Raffles, including manuscript poems by Elizabeth Barrett Browning, Hartley Coleridge, Allan Cunningham, Maria Edgeworth, Mary Howitt, Maria Jane Jewsbury, L.E.L., Thomas Moore, and William Wordsworth. The other is William and Elizabeth Gaskell's own remarkable collection which includes manuscripts by Joanna Baillie, William Cullen Bryant, most of the Coleridges, Oliver Cromwell, Charles Darwin, R.W. Emerson, W.E. Gladstone, Nathaniel Hawthorne, Douglas Jerrold, Charles Lamb, Friedrich Liebniz, Harriet Martineau, Joseph Mazzini, Prosper Merimée, William Pitt, John Ruskin, Georges Sand, Walter Scott, Alfred Tennyson, Anthony Trollope, William Wilberforce and Charlotte Yonge. Many of these letters and poems have their own intrinsic interest but they also bear witness to the disposal of the original papers of such figures as J.H. Wiffen and A.A. Watts.

To enhance the study potential of this archive we have undertaken a detailed listing of the manuscripts concerned giving, where possible, author, addressee, date and place, and titles of all poems and prose works. Errors and misattributions are inevitable in such a work without long-term, painstaking research and consultation with experts in many fields. We welcome any corrections or additions from scholars using the collection and will use these to ammend future editions of the guide.

The Nature of this Guide

This Guide which accompanies the edition contains a quick-reference Contents of Reels, and full descriptive and detailed catalogue entries for each manuscript.


The structure of a typical entry is as follows:

<u>LETTER NO.</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>	<u>PLACE</u>	<u>DATE</u>

The letter number refers to the order of manuscript letters as bound, and appear on the film in the top right-hand corner of each frame.

The correspondent and receiver of the letter are given next. Where long sequences of correspondence from or to one person are involved the full name is replaced by initials only, but full names are given at the start of each new page.

The place and date of writing are given as they appear on the letter. If information has been inferred from another source, e.g. a postmark, watermark or internal evidence, then this information is given in brackets.

The Rev. Thomas Raffles was an avid collector of autographs under headings such as 'Artists', 'Authors and Missionaries', 'Nobility' and 'Poets'. His original manuscript indexes and the autograph collections are preserved in the John Rylands University Library, Manchester. For this microform edition of Nineteenth Century Literary Manuscripts we have included both the index and autograph collection of the 'Poets' section as this contains a large number of original letters and poems by both major and minor poets. For the 'Authors and Missonaries' section (an intriguing conjunction in itself) we have only included the index as the 15 volumes of autographs contains few major authors (nothing by Dickens, Gaskell, Thackeray or Trollope for example) and little or no original literary material.
