

BRITAIN AND EUROPE DURING 1984

This bibliographical guide to Britain and Europe during 1984 accompanies the Harvester/PSS microfiche collection of material produced throughout 1984. It is the twelfth supplement to the 'package' Britain and Europe since 1945, (previously published by Harvester), which contains 26,000 pages of literature issued by 67 groups and organisations between 1945-1972. This update includes material contributed by 33 groups and organisations and, in addition to material produced in 1984, there are a number of items of an earlier date, not previously included.

By 1984 the European Community was over a quarter of a century old and Britain had been a member for more than a decade. But despite the strongly pro-European stance of a Conservative government elected in Britain in 1984 with an increased majority the arguments over the desirability, consequences and practicalities of Common Market membership continued. The British Labour Party made a fresh referendum over withdrawal from the Community a central part of its election platform and groups such as the Anti-Common Market League and British Anti-Common Market Campaign advocated that Britain should return to being an independent trading nation. Incidents such as the forcible hi-jacking of British lorries carrying farm produce to the continent were dramatised, as was the threat to the traditional doorstep delivery of the British pint of milk by the importation of cheaper UHT milk from France. Pro-European groups, and in particular the cluster of pressure groups sharing residence at Europe House in London, stressed the positive aspects of European membership. The fortieth anniversary of the Normandy landings became a focus for the celebration of European harmonisation and a reminder that a central objective of the community was to bring unity and peace to the European continent following two world wars. But the Ministers of member countries were often in open disagreement with each other and arguments over Britain's EEC budgetary contributions raised serious questions concerning the future financing of the EEC and Britain's continued membership.

PLACE/DATE OF PUBLICATION/AUTHORSHIP

Publication dates are given as in the original imprint, except for undated items. Where the date of publication (or origination) has been inferred from reliable internal

or external evidence the conventional form has been adopted: n.d. 1984? Where no named author is listed the item was issued anonymously. The place of publication is normally the address of the issuing body.

HOW TO USE THE INDEX

As with the first collection and previous updates concerned with the Common Market debate, this update - which contains 1984 material issued during 1984 is arranged on the same easily-used and fully-indexed system. In a matter of moments the index takes you from your need for a particular item to the exact document you require.

HARVESTER/PSS UNIQUE PAGE NUMBERS

The Harvester/PSS unique page number again appears in the top left-hand corner of each page. As before the number on the first page of each document is the reference allocated to that particular document. This is the reference you will find in the index. Thus an item of 16 pages with the page numbers, say 80 - 95, will be identified by number 80. The numbering of each group in the 1984 update follows in sequence from the numbering of the material produced by the group in the last collection. For example, the last page of Agenor in Britain and Europe during 1983 was numbered 3850, so the first page of Agenor in the 1984 update is 3851.

HOW TO FIND AN INDIVIDUAL ITEM ON MICROFICHE

This follows the same principles as in the previous collection. Consult either the Chronological Index, the Author Index, or the Title Index to find the title you want. Each document has been allocated a two-letter code. Before this code is a number, which identifies the 'package' followed by 1984 in brackets, which signifies the year of the update. The number after the two-letter code is the number of the specific document.

Suppose you want to read the Conservative Party Pamphlet by Christopher Tugendhat entitled Europe - What Matters now issued in September 1984. You can look for it in any of three places.

A. Chronological Index

You know that the item was issued by the Conservative Party. In the Chronological index this group is given the Britain and Europe since 1945 package number 1, the update number (1984) and the two-letter code IN. Thus the Conservative

Party looks like this:

1(1984)IN

1 is the 'package' reference. (1984) is the year of the update. IN is the group reference.

Each document has been allocated a unique number within the group and this particular document will look like this: 1(1984)IN 4284. TUGENDHAT, Christopher. Europe - What matters now. September 1984, 14pp.

B. Author Index

1(1984)IN 4284 is the unique code for this specific document and in the Author Index it appears like this:

Tugendhat, Christopher, Europe - What Matters now.
Conservative Party, September 1984, 14pp. 1(1984)IN 4284.

C. Title Index

In the Title index it appears like this:

Europe - What Matters now, by Christopher Tugendhat.
Conservative Party, September 1984, 14pp. 1(1984)IN 4284.

When you have the complete code for the document, find the 'package' in the Harvester/PSS collection. This is easily identified through the eye-readable name of the 'package' and through the 'package' number '1' which precedes each code. To identify the year of the update look at the date in brackets next to the package number e.g. (1984)

Then locate the group by the two-letter code. Then pick out the fiche on which the document number appears. Several documents are often filmed on one fiche and the fiche reference will read 1(1984)IN 4283 - 4339. Your document 1(1984)IN 4284 will appear on this fiche.

Insert the fiche in the micro-viewer and move the fiche to read the document you want.

DESCRIPTIONS OF GROUPS AND ORGANISATIONS

There follows a description of groups that are new to this collection.

KANGAROO GROUP - THE MOVEMENT FOR FREE MOVEMENT (1983-continuing)

Millbank Tower, Millbank, London, SW1

The choice of the Kangaroo as the symbol for the new anti-tariff barrier pressure group in Europe was a stroke of marketing brilliance. Ladies dressed in kangaroo suits at airports could not fail to be noticed by the commuting Euro-MP's whom the group sought to influence and the bright personality of the group attracted widespread media attention. Beneath the high-profile public image was a serious political intent. The group noted in their first issue of Kangaroo News that despite the successful removal of the internal tariffs in the early days of the Community, the cost of customs formalities and inspections still imposed a hefty 5-7% cost on intra-community trade. It was these 'non-tariff barriers' which the group wished to leap over - 'as all good kangaroos should'. Furthermore the group advocated a single set of European laws for safety, health and environmental and consumer protection, a single procedure for testing products in compliance with such laws, and greater ease of movement for individuals within the Community whether for tourist or business purposes. The Vice Presidents of the group in 1983 were Basil de Ferranti, Kai Nyborg, Dieter Rogalla, Christiane Scrivener and Karl von Wogau. More than 75 MEP's offered encouragement and support, as did premiers Margaret Thatcher, Dr Wilfried Martens, Ruud Lubbers and Poul Schluter, and leading Europeans of the calibre of Christopher Tugendhat (Vice President of the Commission), Karl-Heinz Narjes (EEC Commissioner for the Internal Market) and Pieter Dankert (President of the European Parliament). The latter expressed his hopes that "a few well aimed kicks from the kangaroos' hind legs" might make the European governments take notice of the frustrations and grievances of European businessmen concerning VAT, customs delays and red tape. The Editor of Kangaroo News was Pamela Entwistle, who worked from a prestige office next to the Tate Gallery at the side of the River Thames. Specifically British publications were produced with detailed articles on the problems encountered by banking, insurance, computing and electrical industries in trading in a supposedly Common Market. Support groups were also encouraged throughout Europe with their own publications and activities.
