## 1868-1916

CABINET LETTERS

IN THE ROYAL ARCHIVES

Until the formation of the Cabinet Secretariat in December 1916 no minutes were kept of proceedings at Cabinet meetings. The only record of Cabinet decisions was contained in the letters written by Prime Ministers to the Sovereign after each meeting. These letters, which vary from brief statements of subjects discussed to more detailed accounts of arguments made and decisions reached, are preserved in the Royal Archives at Windsor Castle. Drafts and copies of some are found in other collections, such as the Gladstone papers (in the British Museum), the Salisbury papers (at Christ Church, Oxford), and the Asquith papers (in the Bodleian).

Her Majesty the Queen graciously has given her permission for a microfilm edition to be made of almost 1700 of these letters written between 1868 and 1916. The following list indicates briefly the subjects mentioned in each report. Most letters appear to have been written on the same day as the Cabinet meeting; but when a letter refers to a meeting on a previous day the list shows the date of the meeting in square brackets.

In 1965 the List and Index Society produced a listing of these letters and the present revised version, with many additions and corrections, has been filmed in its entirety. The material is Crown copyright and has been reproduced with the permission of Her Majesty's Stationery Office.
